

WILLIAM RAMÍREZ PIZARRO

Born on August 13, 1968 in Merida, Yucatan. He made his professional studies at the Facultad de Arquitectura at the Universidad Autonoma de Yucatan and in 1992 obtained the title of ARCHITECT. He was partner of Ramírez Contreras Arquitectos firm from 1991 to 1994, CEO of Ramírez Arquitectos firm since 1994 and Partner of Grupo Arquidecure firm since 2005. Professor at the Facultad de Arquitectura UADY from 1993 to 1995. Board Member of the College of Yucatan Architects from 2001 to 2002 and from 2003 to 2004. Member of the Mexican Society of Architects Specialized in Healthcare (SMAES). AIA International Member. In 2010 he obtained professional certification from the National Registry of Professional Certification (CONARC) and the Forum of Asia-Pacific Economic Cooperation (APEC).

His projects have been recognized locally in the Yucatan architecture biennials, in national events such as the Mexican architectural biennials, regional biennials, and the "Obras Cemex" award. He has also been awarded in international events like the "Leading Culture Destinations Awards" and "Partnerships Awards" both from London, England, the Biennial of Architecture in Costa Rica, the Iberoamerican Biennial CIDI and the "Argentine Association of Hospital Architecture and Engineering Awards".
